	Points Achievable	Score Given
<u>Polish</u> Bright red creme gel polish must be applied to the thumb and pinkie only. Coverage must be smooth and even, with a consistent 1 mm cuticle gap. The surface, sides and free edge must be covered, with no streaking, flooding or product on the skin, beneath the nail or in the concave.	10	
<u>Finish / High Shine</u> All five nails must be sealed with a transparent gel top coat and show a flawless glass-like shine over the entire convex surface. The finish must be smooth and even, with no visible file scratches, dull or matte areas, bubbles, pitting or flooding.	10	
<u>Hairline & Free Edge Thickness</u> All five nails must be consistently and uniformly thin, including through the hairline and free edge, with no nail thicker than a standard business card. Thinner, consistent work demonstrates a higher degree of technical control.	10	
<u>Nail Length</u> All five nails must be consistent and proportionate to the hand and fingers. The pinkie must be shortest; the ring and index must match; and the middle finger and thumb must be longest. Each extension must measure between 50% and 100% of its natural nail-bed length.	10

	Points Achievable	Score Given
<u>Lower Arch / Lower Side Line</u> Lower side lines must be straight, even and clean, extending directly from the lateral folds without ridges or steps. They must run parallel to the upper arch and finish at equal heights when viewed from the tunnel or hairline perspective.	10	
<u>Upper Arch / Upper Side Line</u> From the side view, the upper arch must run parallel to the lower arch and remain consistent across all five nails. From the top view, side lines must extend straight from the natural lateral walls, without widening, tapering or being filed away.	10	
<u>Cuticle Area</u> Product must be applied evenly and close to the cuticle with no gaps, ledges, flooding or missing product. The enhancement should appear to grow naturally from the nail. Surrounding skin must be clean and free from cuts or irritation; pre-existing damage declared to the floor judge must be considered.	10	
<u>Smile Line</u> The three French smile lines must be sharp, clean, symmetrical and consistent, with no shadows, waves, pits, marbling or colour bleed. The index and ring must match; the middle must be proportionately longer. End points must be equal, crisp and finish within the lateral folds. The pink-to-white ratio must be 1:1.	10

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	Points Achievable	Score Given
<u>Apex</u> The apex must be correctly placed between 25% and 50% of the nail-bed length and consistently positioned across all five nails. It must form a smooth, elegant arch appropriate to the nail, without being flat, bulky or overly pronounced.	10	
<u>White Extension / Application of White</u> White product must be evenly applied across the three French nails, with no shadows, bubbles, pits, cloudiness or colour contamination. The division between pink and white must be sharp and clearly defined. The French must be constructed with white acrylic powder; paint-on French is not permitted.	10	
<u>C-Curve / C-Arch</u> The C-curve must be symmetrical and consistent through the full length of all five nails in both convex and concave views. It must be more than 40% and less than 50% of a full circle, with the chosen depth maintained uniformly across every nail.	10	
<u>Nail Bed / Application of Pink, Clear or Cover</u> Nail-bed product must be even and consistent across the three French nails, with no shadows, bubbles, pits, cloudiness or marbling. One colour must be used throughout and complement the model's skin tone. The cuticle blend must be smooth; index and ring nail beds must match, with the middle proportionately longer. The nail bed must be constructed using permitted acrylic powder products.	10	
<u>Nail Shape</u> All five nails must have a consistent square shape from the top, side and model's view. Free edges must form clean 90-degree corners, and side lines must extend straight from the lateral walls without flaring, tapering or twisting.	10
